SUBSIDIA

QUIBUS IN DELINEANDIS TABULIS USI SUMUS.

HANNONIS navigatio ut illustraretur (tabb. 1 et 2), oram Lybiæ occidentalem descripsi secundum tabulas nauticas quæ nuperrime Parisiis prodierunt (*Côte occidentale d'Afrique. Au dépôt de la marine, 1852*), simul adhibitis tabulis quæ inscribuntur : *West Coast of Africa surveyed by Arlett, Vidal, Boteler, etc., 1835* sqq., et : *Carte de l'empire de Maroc par E. Renou, membre de la commission scientifique d'Algérie, 1844*, et quam Henricus Barthius dedit : *Karte vom Nordafrikanischen Gestadeland (Berlin, 1849)*.

De tabulis quæ ad SCYLACEM pertinent, non est quod moneatur, quum summis lineolis maris interni oram leviter adumbrasse pro ratione peripli Scylacei satis esset.

SINUS ARABICI descriptio (tabb. 6-8) mappis nititur hisce : *Chart of the Red Sea on Mercators projection compiled from a stasimetric survey executed in the years 1830, 31, 32 et 33 in the honorable company's ship Palinurus by commander R. Moresby and lieut. F. G. Carless (4 tabb.)*. — *Carte de la mer Rouge dressée par M. Daussy d'après les travaux de Mss. Moresby et Elwon. (Dépôt de la marine, 1849)*. — *Südwestliches Arabien (Hidjaz und Jemen) zu C. Ritters Erdkunde bearbeitet von H. Kiepert, herausgegeben von C. Ritter. Berlin, 1852*. — *Arabia und das Nil-land von H. Berghaus. Gotha, 1835*.

In ISIDORI mansionibus Parthicis Euphratis particulas (tab. 9) dedimus ex opere Chesneyi : *Survey of the rivers Euphrates and Tigris*. Cetera (tab. 10) superstructa sunt tabulis Kiepertianis : *Uebersichts-Karte von Iran oder West-Hochasien et Turan oder Türkistan. Berlin, 1852*.

Quod PERIPLUM MARIS ERYTHREI attinet, ora Libyæ orientalis (tab. 12) delineata est secundum : *Carte de l'entrée de la mer Rouge dressée par M. Daussy, ingénieur hydrographe en chef, d'après les travaux les plus récents. (Au dépôt général de la marine, 1840)*, et *Carte du canal de Mozambique, etc.*, quam eidem debemus Daussyo. — In describenda ora aromatifera secuti sumus tabulas quibus titulus est : *Trigonometrical survey of the northeast coast of Africa by lieut. F. G. Carless, J. N., assisted by Messrs Ball, Whitburn, Selby and Scott, midsh., Indian navy, 1838*. — Arabiæ oram australem (tab. 13) habes secundum Arabiæ tabulam quam dedit Kiepertus, edidit Ritterus (Berlin, 1852); Dachinabadæ oram (tab. 14) secun-



dum Berghausium (*Generalkarte von Vorderindien*, 1836) et Kiepertum (*Die Halbinsel Vorderindien mit Ceylon*, 1852).

In NEARCHI navigatione (tab. 15) regionem Indo proximam expressimus ex tabulis Caroli Zimmermann (*Das Stromgebiet des Indus in 6 Blättern*, Berlin, 1851); in reliquis oræ partibus adhibuimus: *Central Asia constructed from numerous authentic documents, but principally from the original surveys of lieut. Alex. Burnes, by J. Arrowsmith*; — *Berghaus, Reduzirte Karte vom Persischen Golf*; — *Chesney, Survey of the rivers Euphrates and Tigris*.

PONTI EUXINI (tab. 17, 18) ora meridionalis datur sec. Kiepti *Karte von Kleinasien* (Berlin, 1844; 6 Blätter), orientalis vero ora ducta est ex mappa nautica quam Petropoli russice edidit Manginari (1844).

LIBYÆ oram borealem (tab. 19-23) exaravimus secundum tabulas nauticas quas composuit *Captain W. H. Smyth*; simul adhibuimus quæ præbent Beechey in *Proceedings of the expedition to explore the northern coast of Africa from Tripoly eastwards in 1821 et 1822* (London, 1828) et H. Barth in tabula quam junxit operi: *Wanderungen durch die Küsterländer der Mittelmeers* (Berlin, 1849). Situs Carthaginis urbis in tab. 23 repræsentatur sec. *Dureau de la Malle in Recherches sur la topographie de Carthage* (Paris, 1835).

In tabb. 24 et 25 præter Kiepti Asiam minorem usi sumus Chesneyi tabula: *The Cilician Taurus and Northern Syria* et Lyciæ tabula, quam ediderunt F. A. B. Spratt et E. Forbes (in *Travels in Lycia, Milyas and the Cibyratis*, London, 1847). Eorundem ex opere petivimus quæ de ruinis Antiphelli et Tenedi interposuimus.

CYPRUM insulam (tab. 26) ut accuratius describere possemus, insigni debetur humanitati viri doctissimi, MAS-LATRIE, qui quam construxit amplissimam Cypri tabulam (*Carte de Chypre pour servir à l'histoire des Lusignan*) benigne nobiscum communicavit.

CRETAM insulam delineavimus sec. *Carte générale de la Turquie d'Europe en 15 feuilles par Lapie*, adhibitis tabulis Kiepti (*Atlas von Hellas und den hellen. Colonien*) et Paschleyi (*Travels in Crete*. London, 1837).

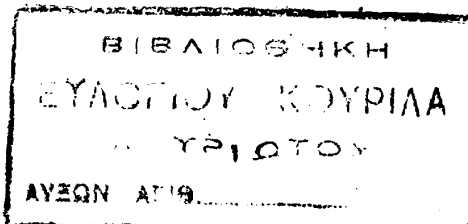
